9.4. Munitions Forecast Guidelines and Annual Worksheet. Using the worksheet in table 9.2 and guidelines in the following paragraphs will simplify your annual munitions forecast. To determine the unit's annual munitions requirement, simply multiply the unit's number of assigned agents (active duty, civilian, and Reserve) or weapons times the listed annual authorization. Include those Reserve agents who are assigned to other units but reside in and train in your area of responsibility. Submit your requirements to your location's munitions supply personnel. Each MAJCOM has its own procedures and format; however, all the information needed should be easy to compile if the munitions custodian uses the worksheet. Simply expand the annual forecast to include a 5-year period to satisfy the 5-year extended forecast requirement.

9.4.1. Your SF combat arms unit will forecast all Category D (training) munitions for Air Force qualification courses. Be sure to call your SF combat arms unit to update the munitions forecast for qualification training (number of assigned agents that require training, etc.). Include civilians or reservists that require qualification.
